Our industry's lead times times

extend from a few days to a few weeks - a change that catches some buyers off guard, especially if their own market does not echo this seasonal peak.

Please help us to help you by placing the rest of your 2023 orders as soon as possible. This will enable us to secure machine time with board suppliers and our own production capacity at times to optimally suit you, rather than requiring you to wait until packaging is going to be available. We'll also be able to maintain our policy of retaining some spare capacity every week - to enable us to respond to emergency requirements.
